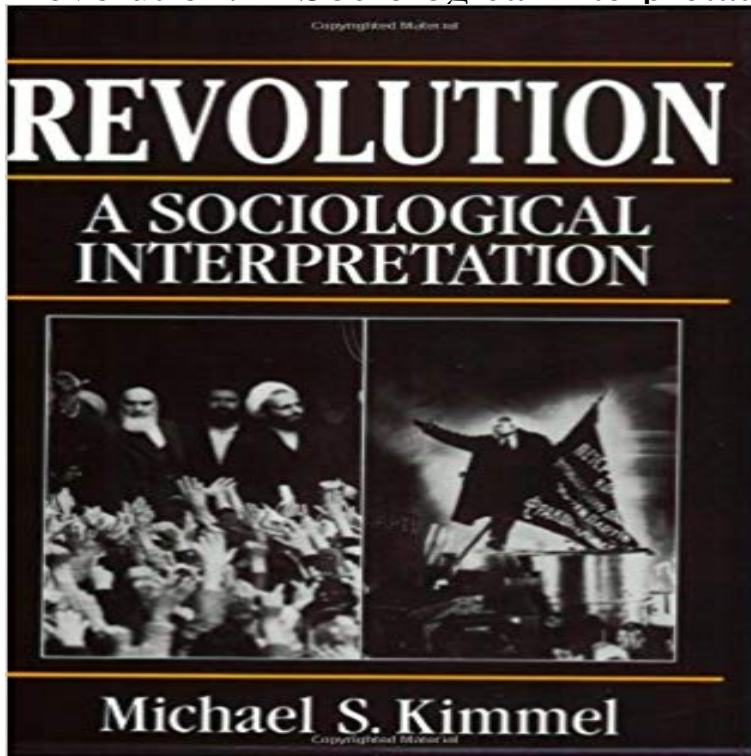


Revolution: A Sociological Interpretation
