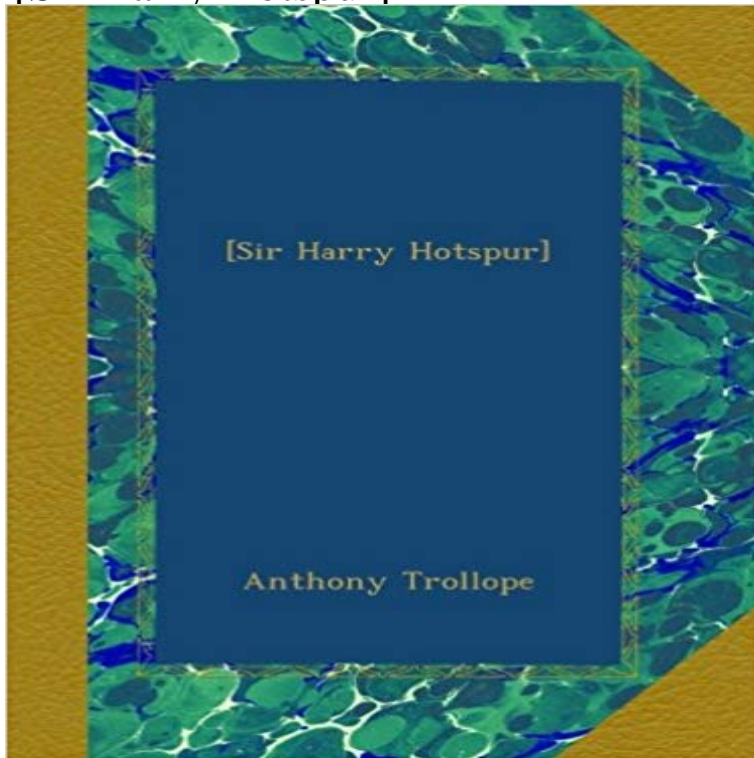


[Sir Harry Hotspur]
