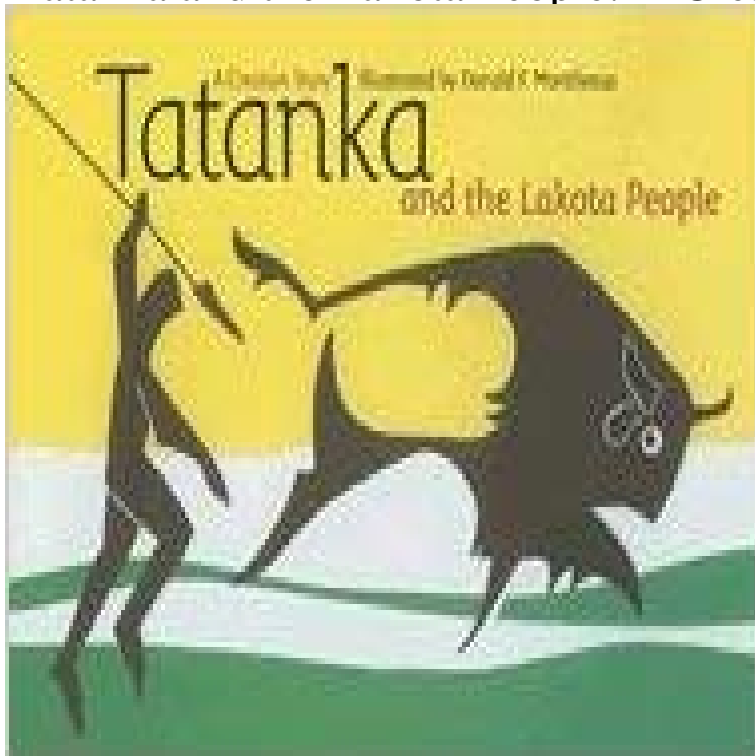


## Tatanka and the Lakota People: A Creation Story
