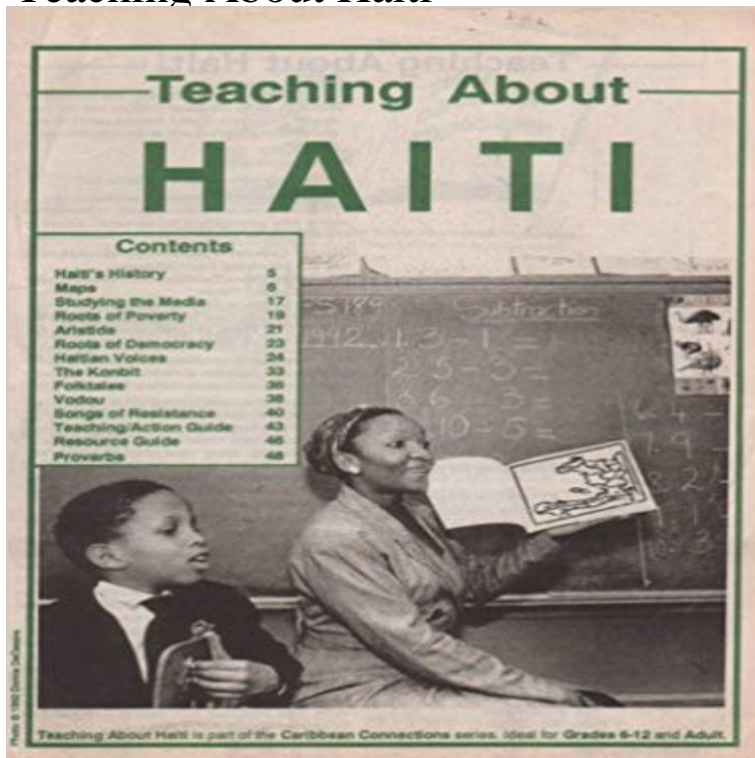


Teaching About Haiti
