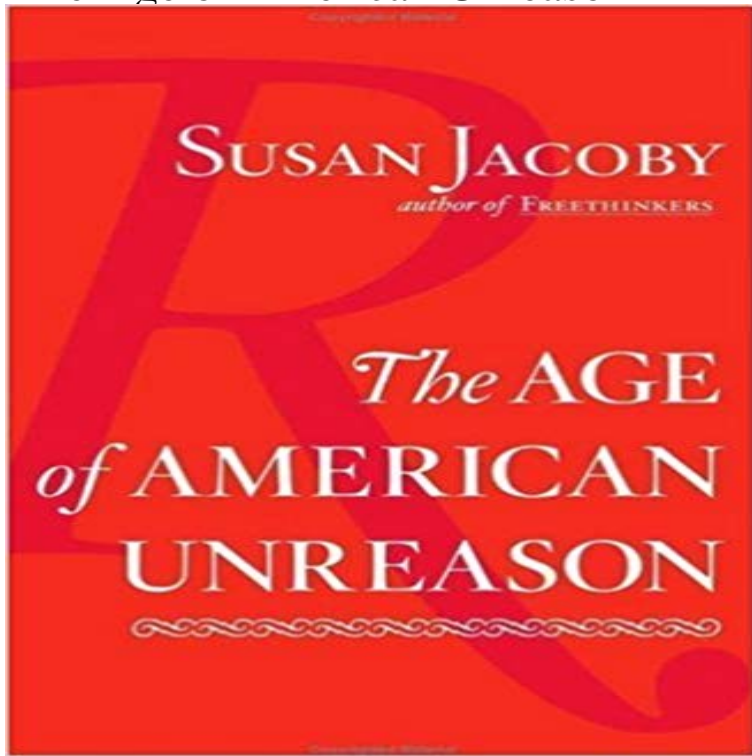


The Age of American Unreason
