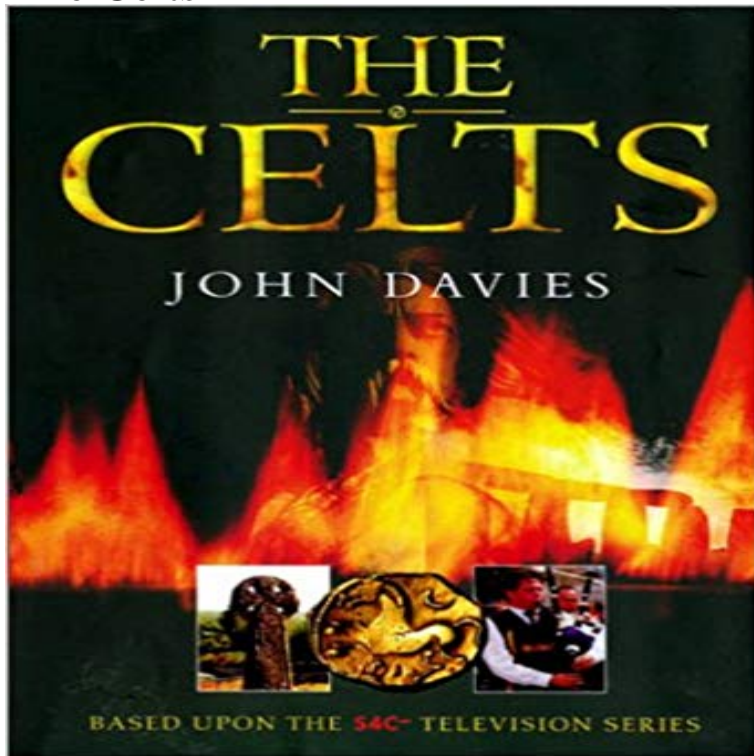


## The Celts
