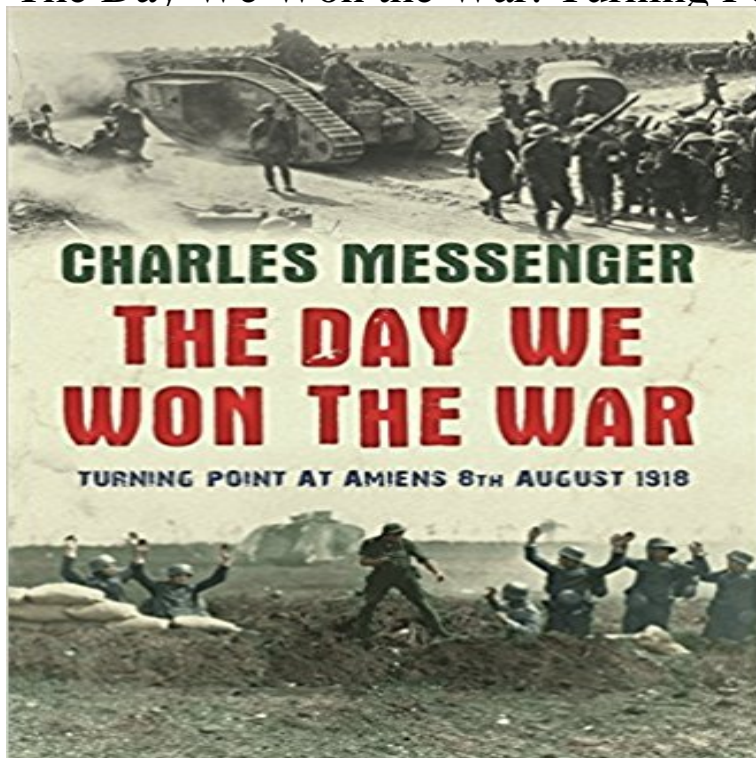


The Day We Won the War: Turning Point at Amiens 8th August 1918
