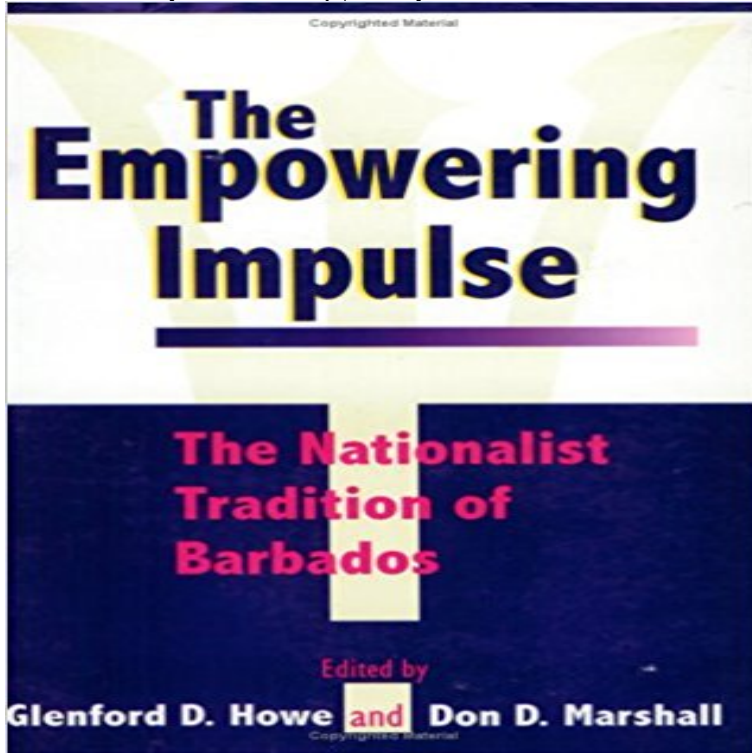


# The Empowering Impulse: The Nationalist Tradition of Barbados
