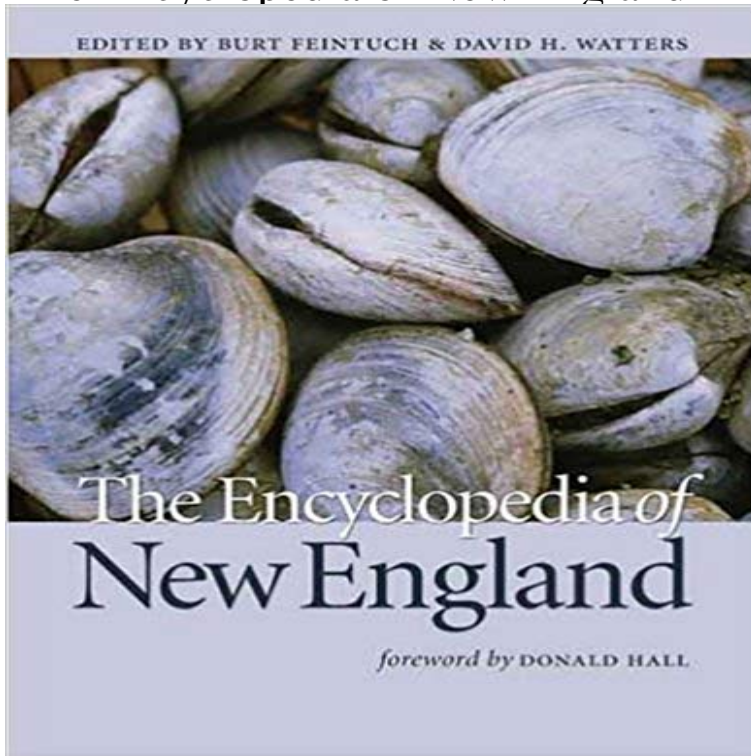


# The Encyclopedia of New England
