
The Globalization of Contentious Politics: The Amazonian Indigenous Rights Movement (Indigenous Peoples and Politics)



This dissertation argues that Amazonian indigenous peoples organized transnational networks due to the domestic blockages presented to them in their respective countires. Due to blockages and the growing number of transnational political opportunity structures, such as national international non-govermental organizations, multi-lateral development banks, and multinational corporation, indigenous peoples mobilized through advocacy networks and transnational eventually formed transnational social organizations. Through movement comparative-historical analysis of five Ecuadorian Amazonian indigenous organizations, this work illustrates the processes of transnational collective action and its outcomes.
