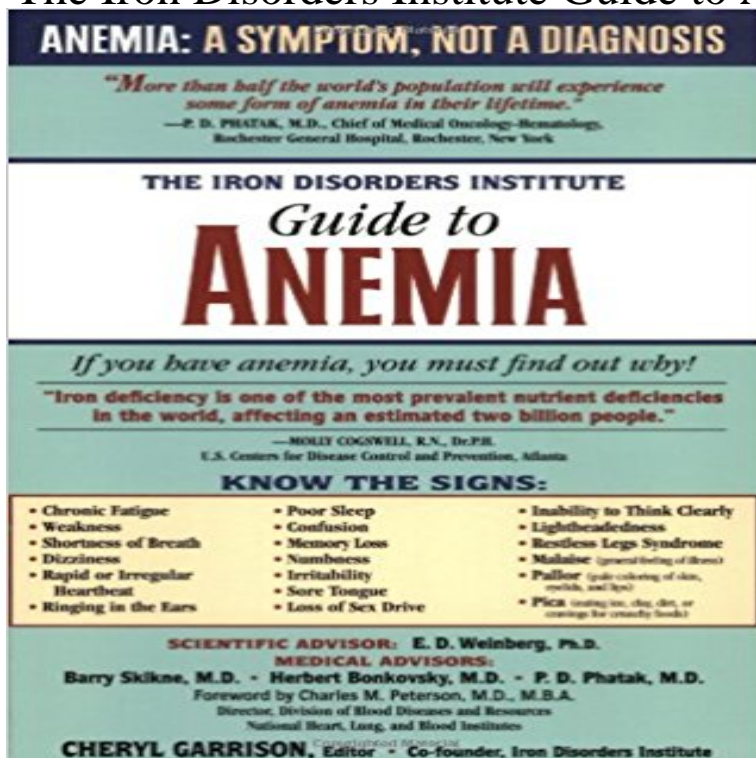


The Iron Disorders Institute Guide to Anemia
