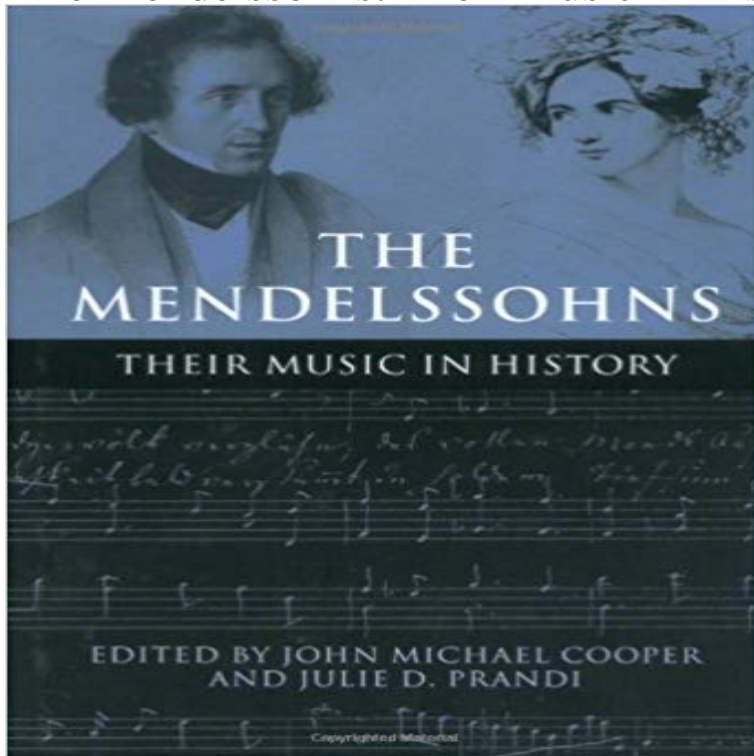


## The Mendelssohns: Their Music in History
