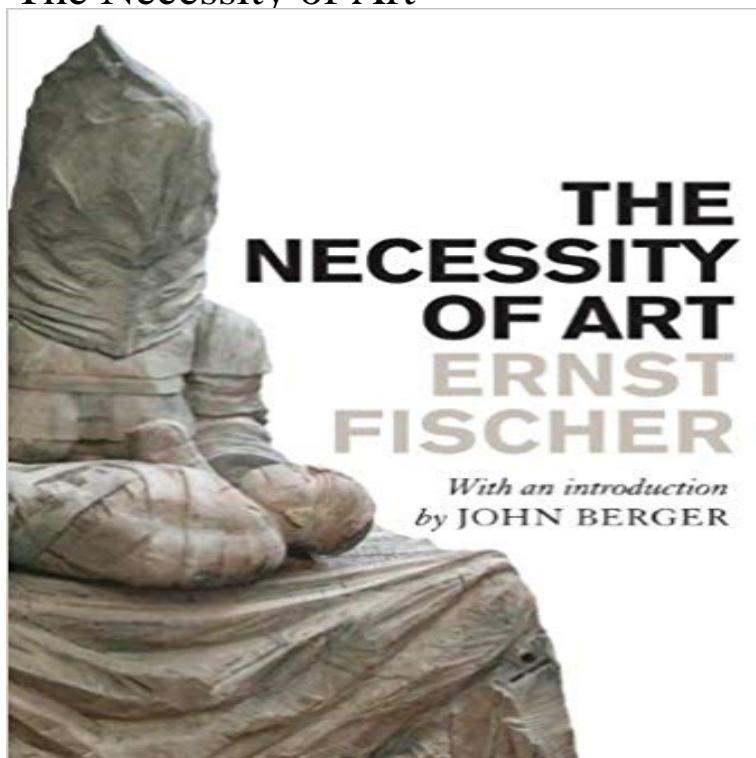


The Necessity of Art
