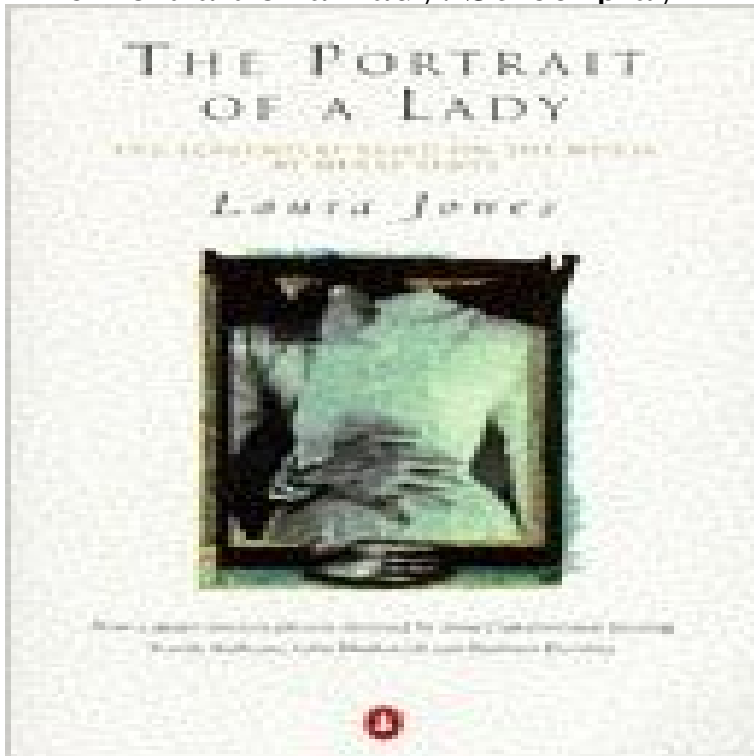


The Portrait of a Lady: Screenplay
