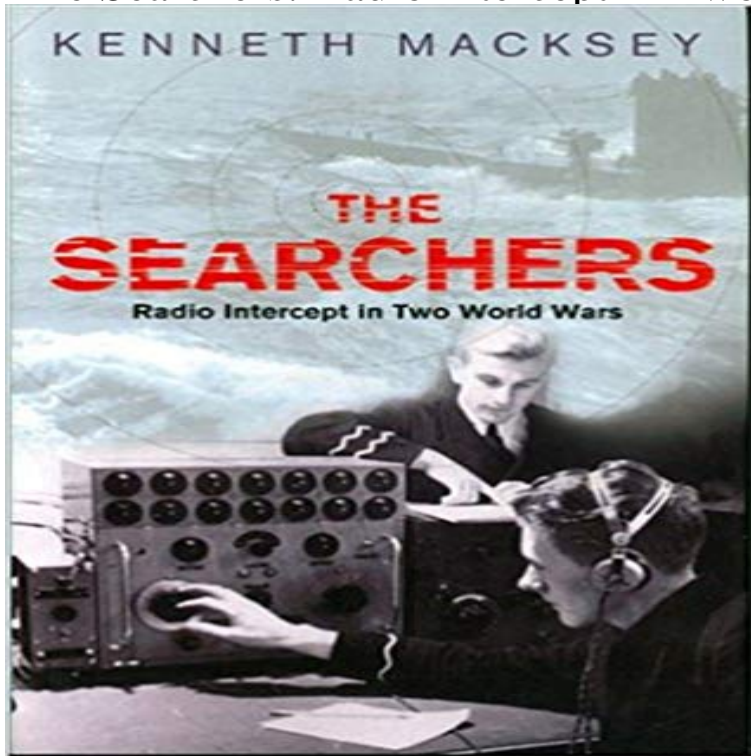


The Searchers: Radio Intercept in Two World Wars
