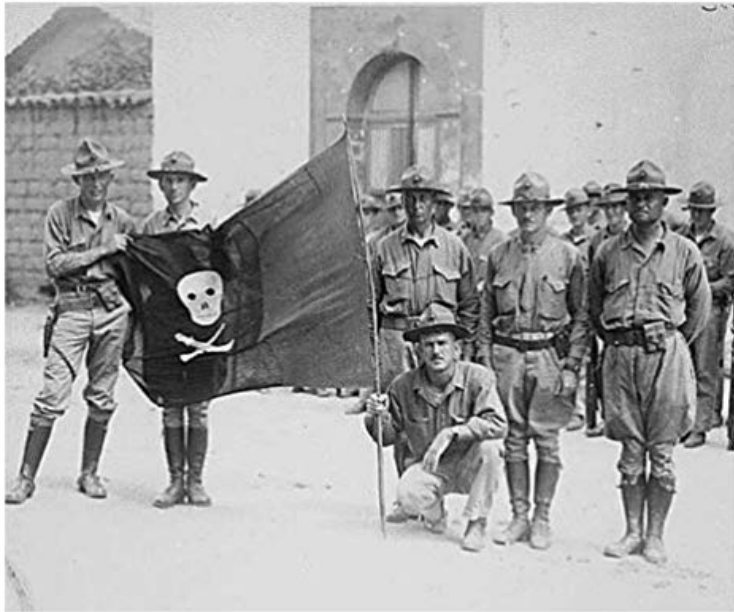

A large force of rebels loyal to Augusto Cesar Sandino attacked the garrison of Ocotal, which was held by a small group of US Marines and Nicaraguan National Guards.
