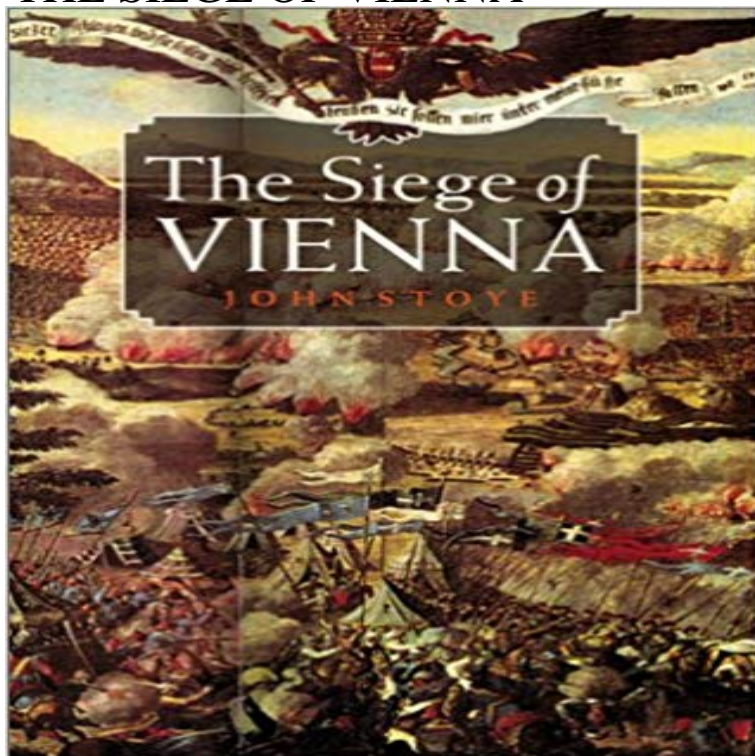


## THE SIEGE OF VIENNA
