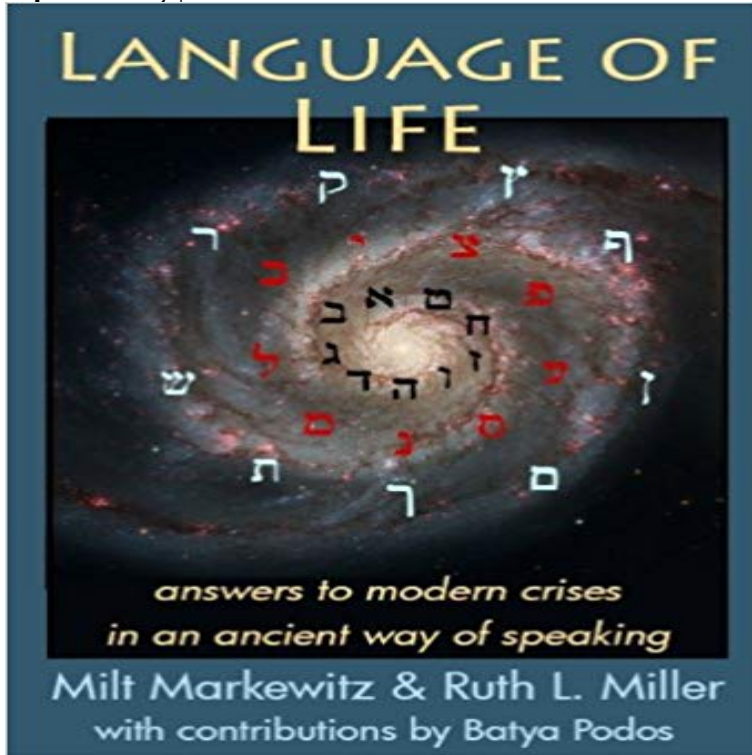


Language of Life, answers to modern crises in an ancient way of speaking
