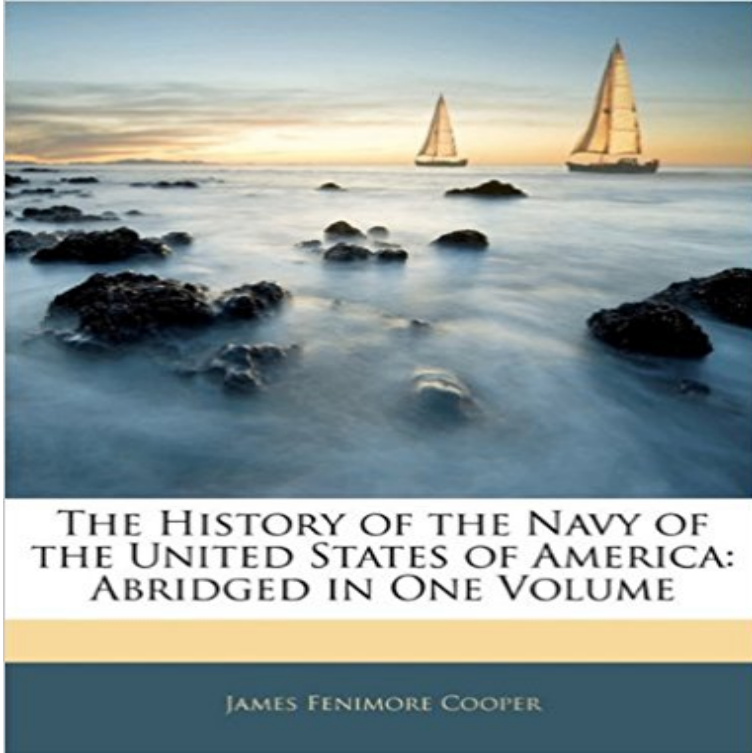


# The History of the Navy of the United States of America: Abridged in One Volume
