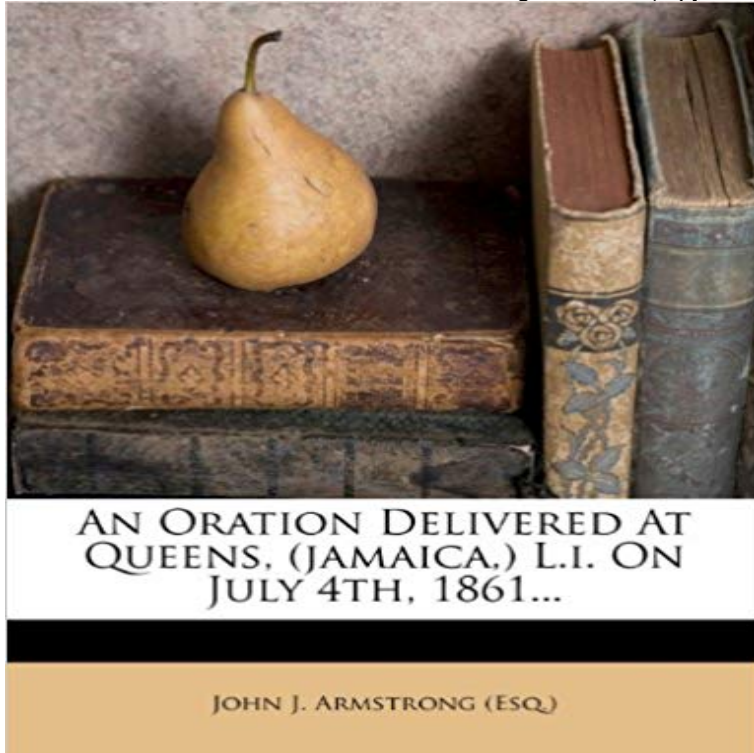


## An Oration Delivered At Queens, (jamaica,) L.i. On July 4th, 1861...
