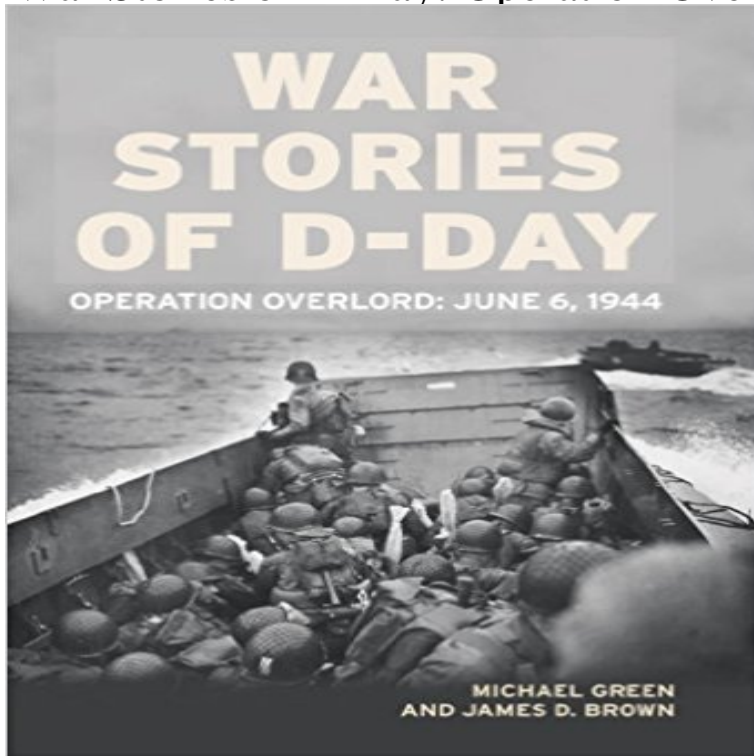


War Stories of D-Day: Operation Overlord: June 6, 1944
