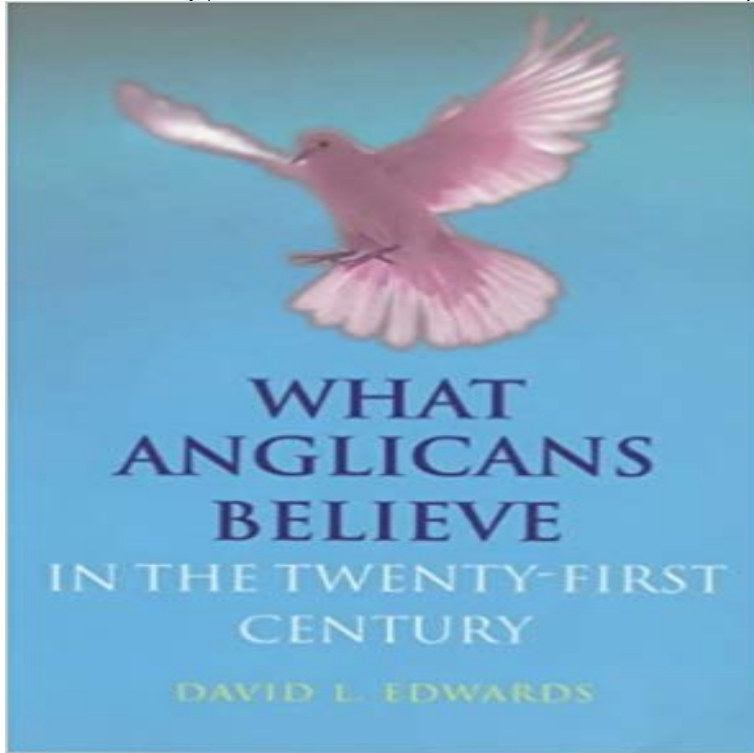


What Anglicans Believe in the Twenty-First Century
