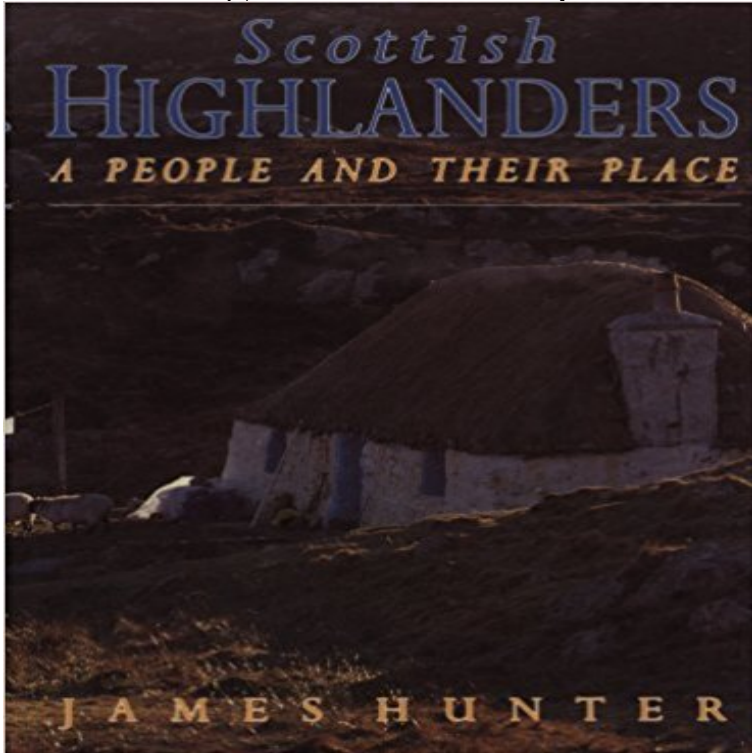


Scottish Highlanders: A People and Their Place
