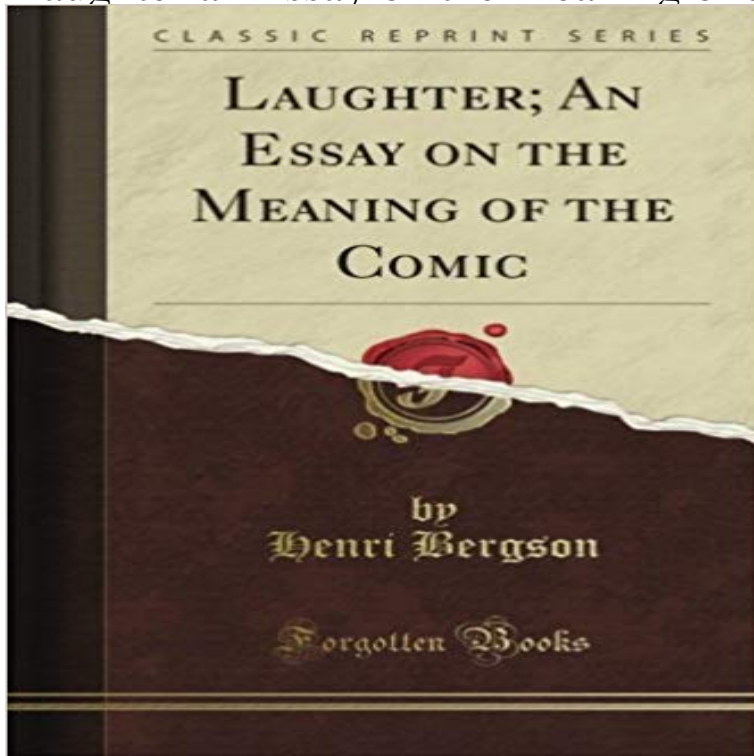


Laughter an Essay on the Meaning of the Comic (Classic Reprint)
