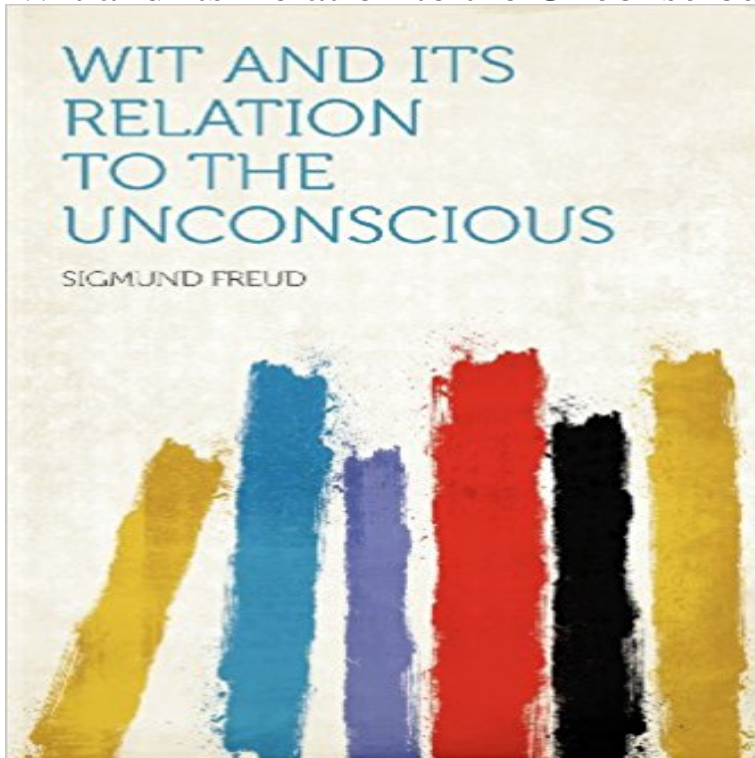


Wit and Its Relation to the Unconscious
